

## Max file size = 10mb per file

There is **no limit to the number of files** you are allowed to submit, however, if your assessment consists of multiple tasks and you are using the same software product to submit them, save as a single document. (eg. 6 x tasks = 1 word file) this makes it much easier for the Marker to review.

### File too large?

Have you embedded (pasted) any of the following directly into your assessment file

-  A large picture/image
-  A scanned document
-  An excel spreadsheet

Try deleting the offending item and see how the size of your file changes?

### Scanning

Most scanners are configured to output at a high resolution, ie photographic quality (300-600 dpi). You will need to change the output resolution to a lower quality (60-70 dpi) – this will create an image of a smaller size which is adequate for viewing online.

All objects that you intend to embed in your submission file should be scanned/re-sized

### Checking file size

Depending on how you view files you may be able to confirm the file size simply by locating it on your computer/device:

 unep.xlsx Microsoft Excel Worksheet 20.7 KB	small
 Assessment.pdf Adobe Acrobat Document 408 KB	small
 02_TAEDS401A.pdf 2,397 KB	Medium = approx. 2mb
 Assesment.pdf 20,567 KB	Too large – limit 10 mb this file = 20 mb

Note: 1 MB= 1024 KB

If your view does not show the size of the file, right-click on the file and select Properties – check the size as above
